GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Insecticide Resistance Warning

For insecticide resistance management DEMAND Insecticide is a Group 3A insecticide. Some naturally occurring insect biotypes resistant to DEMAND and other Group 3A insecticides may exist through normal genetic variability in any insect population. The resistant individuals can eventually dominate the insect population if DEMAND or other Group 3A insecticides are used repeatedly. The effectiveness of DEMAND on resistant individuals could be significantly reduced. Mixing

1. Half fill the spray tank with water.
2. Using the auto-measure fill the reservoir with the correct amount of DEMAND by unscrewing the bottle cap a ¼ turn and squeezing the bottle.
3. Fully unscrew the bottle cap and pour the measured dose of DEMAND into the sprayer. Replace and tighten bottle cap.
4. Add the remaining water, close sprayer, shake and pump to correct pressure and apply spray.

PRECAUTIONS

Cover all foodstuffs before application. DO NOT allow spray to contact food, food preparation surfaces and utensils.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT

Harmful to fish. DO NOT contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers. DO NOT discharge the liquid into waterways. Remove or cover fish tanks before use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in the closed, original container in a cool, well ventilated area. DO NOT store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple or preferably pressure rinse empty containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. DO NOT dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

Domestic, Public Service, Commercial and Industrial situations	German Cockroaches (clean out), Cat Flea	200 mL	Apply dilute spray at the rate of 10 L/200 m ² or to run off. Crawling insects: Apply as a coarse low pressure spray to areas where pests hide. Flying insects: Apply as a residual surface treatment. All people and animals should be removed from buildings prior to treatment.
